



## THE COVENANT UNTO GOD BY THE SECOND CHURCH IN BOSTON, NEW ENGLAND MARCH 17, 1680

We who through the exceeding riches of the grace and patience of God do yet continue members of this church, being now assembled in the holy presence of God and in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; after humble confession of our manifold breaches of Covenant before the Lord our God and earnest supplications for pardoning mercy through the blood of Christ and deep acknowledgement of our great unworthiness to be owned as the Lord's Covenant people; also acknowledging our inability to keep Covenant with God or to perform any spiritual duty unless the Lord Jesus do enable us thereunto by His Spirit dwelling in us; and being awfully sensible that it is a dreadful thing for sinful dust and ashes personally to transact with the infinitely glorious Majesty of heaven and earth, we do in humble confidence of His gracious assistance and acceptance through Christ, each one of us, for ourselves, and jointly, as a church of the living God, explicitly renew our Covenant with God and one with another in manner and form following. That is to say,

We do give up ourselves unto that God whose name alone is Jehovah, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as the only true and living God and unto our blessed Lord Jesus Christ as our only Saviour, Prophet, Priest and King over our souls and only Mediator of the Covenant of Grace; promising (by the help of His Spirit and grace) to cleave unto God as our chief good and unto the Lord Jesus Christ by faith in a way of Gospel obedience as becometh His Covenant people for ever. We do also give up our offspring unto God in Jesus Christ, avouching the Lord to be our God and the God of our children and ourselves with our children to be His people; humbly adjuring this grace of God, that we and our offspring with us may be looked upon as the Lord's.

We do also give up ourselves one unto another, in the Lord according to the will of God, freely covenanting and binding ourselves to walk together as a right ordered congregation and Church of Christ; in all the ways of His worship, according to the holy rules of the Word of God; promising, in brotherly love, faithfully to watch over one another's souls and to submit ourselves unto the discipline and government of Christ and His church and duly to attend the seals, censures or whatever ordinances Christ has commanded to be observed by His people, according to the order of the Gospel, so far as the Lord hath or shall reveal more unto us by His Word and Spirit.

And whereas the Messengers of these Churches, who have met together

in the name of Christ to enquire into the reason of the Lord's controversy with this His people, have taken notice of many provoking evils as the procuring cause of the judgments of God upon New-England; so far as we, or any of us, have been guilty of sin in respect to any of them, we desire from our hearts to bewail it before the Lord and humbly to entreat for pardoning mercy for the sake of the blood of the everlasting Covenant.

And as an expedient unto reformation of those or whatever evils have provoked the eyes of God's glory among us, we do subjoin unto our church Covenant a further engagement, whereby we do, as in the presence of God, promise,

- 1. That we will (by the help of Christ) labor, every one of us, to reform his own heart and life by seeking to mortify all our sin and endeavouring to walk more closely with God than ever we have done and to uphold the power of godliness; and that we will continue to worship God in public, private, secret, and this (as God shall help us) without formality and hypocrisy; and more fully and faithfully than heretofore, to discharge all Covenant duties one towards another in a way of church communion.
- 2. We promise (by the help of Christ) that we will endeavour to walk before God in our houses with a perfect heart and that we will uphold the worship of God therein continually, according as He in His Word doth require, both in respect of prayer and reading the Scriptures, so that the Word of Christ may dwell richly in us; and that we will do what in us lyeth, to bring up our children for Christ, that they may become such, as they that have the Lord's name put upon them by a solemn dedication to God in Christ, ought to be; and that therefore we will (so far as there shall be need of it) catechize them, and exhort and charge them to fear and serve the Lord, and endeavour to set an holy example before them, and be much in prayer for their conversion and salvation.
- 3. We do further engage (the Lord helping us) to do what in us is, that we may be pure from the sins of the times, even those provoking evils that have brought the judgment of God upon New-England; and in our places to endeavour the suppression thereof; and that we will make conscience to walk so, as that we may not give occasion to others to sin or to speak evil of our holy profession.

Now, that we may observe and keep this sacred Covenant and all the branches of it inviolable for ever, we desire to deny ourselves, to depend wholly upon the power of the eternal Spirit of Grace, and upon the free mercy of God, and upon the merit of Jesus Christ, and where we shall fail, there to wait upon the Lord Jesus for pardon, and for acceptance, and for healing, for his name's sake.

### DECLARATION, COMMITMENT, COVENANT TO GOD

#### An Act of Contrition and Humble Repentance before our Lord

on this 23rd day of March, in the year of our Lord 2002, with my brothers and sisters in Christ as witnesses, I have solemnly gathered with other serious and convicted Believers in the Ventura County Church, in contrition and humble repentance, confessing many of the multitudinous and grievious sins of our Nation, our Church, and personally. Dear Lord God my Creator and my Father, from the depths of my heart in honest and genuine sincerity, I make a solemn oath to You, to turn away from my wicked ways, having fallen short in honoring and glorifying You. I repent of my personal sins, and acknowledge those of our Nation and the Church corporately.

I humbly ask and plead for your gracious mercy and grace through the atoning work of my Saviour and Lord Jesus Christ at this most holy Easter season. I confess, I repent, and I promise and commit in a consecrated personal covenant with You Lord God Almighty, to trust You, honor You, love You and obey You with a heart and lifestyle change, through the enabling power of the Holy Spirit, Who gives me the ability to do so, as a new creation in Christ. I commit to You all areas of my life as a living sacrifice unto You, to be well pleasing in Your sight, and as much as I am able, to pursue holiness, righteousness and peace and to work and serve You whereever You have called me and do so with perseverence, thankfully and joyfully to the praise and honor and glory of Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace and King of Kings.
